Homework

Literacy:

- Spelling - Spelling lists will be given out on Fridays and the children will have a test on the Friday of that week. The children are expected to learn and practise spellings during the week. They have a copy at home and a copy in school to minimise delays in learning/practise.
- Reading - Reading diaries have been allocated to the children. They are expected to read at least 3 times a week for at least 15 minutes and to provide a short written response on each occasion. Please encourage your child to read a broad range of genres. This is SEPARATE to our reading challenge.
- Grammar - We will set two pages every Friday which must be completed by the following Friday.

Numeracy:

- Homework - This will be distributed on a Friday. It is due back the following Friday. Children should approach their teachers if they are unsure of anything - they have got all week!
- Times tables - Please continue to learn times tables with your child regularly as they form a VITAL part of most, if not all, aspects of number work. There are some very good websites which teach times tables in a 'fun' way! Please find links to these on the Warden Hill website.

Assessment For Learning

The children form a very important role in assessing themselves in their learning.

They are encouraged to critically evaluate and edit their own work and those of others.

Marking is a dialogue between the teacher and the pupil.

- Children need to respond by correcting their own mistakes.

- After every session, children also traffic light their work to indicate confidence.

We mark in pink and green. 'Tickled pink' - great work!
