ASSESSMENT FOR LEARNING

The children have a very important role in assessing themselves in their learning.

They are encouraged to critically evaluate and edit their own work and those of others.

Marking is a dialogue between the teacher and the pupil.


- Children need to respond by correcting their own mistakes.

- We mark in pink and green. 'Tickled pink' - great work! 'Green for growth' - an area to be improved.

HOMework

English:

- Spelling - Spelling lists will be given out on Fridays and the children will have a test on the Friday of the next week. The children are expected to learn and practise spellings during the week. They have a copy at home and a copy in school to minimise delays in learning/practise.
- Reading - Reading Diaries have been given to the children. Children need to read at least 4 times a week and record this in their reading log. They may read either to an adult or independently. Once a week, the children will write a detailed response to a task that will be set by the class teacher. This will be a label stuck into their book. This Reading Diary should be brought into school daily so that their reading is monitored.

Grammar and Maths: Each week the children will be set daily questions to complete every weekday evening. These tasks will link to the learning that is going on in class and will be discussed and marked with the children. There will be no homework set over weekends.

If your child has tried to complete the homework but if they have found it difficult, please write a note next to the question and we will support them in school the following day.

If your child hasn't completed their homework they will be asked to do it independently at break time.
