Book Swap Procedure

Dear Parents

This letter is to inform you of some changes that we will be making regarding the book swap process, in order to reduce the risk of COVID-19 contamination.

If your child is returning to school on Monday 8th June, please can you return any school books that you have at home, as well as your child's green keyword book, in a bag that we can dispose of. Books that are returned will be held in school, untouched, for a period of at least 72 hours before they will be re-circulated. The frequency of book change will be once a week, three books at a time. Your child will be given three new books to take home in a named plastic wallet to be read and brought back to school, in that same wallet, on Thursday 11th June. From then on we will start a weekly cycle. Three books will be given to your child on a Thursday, to be returned the following Thursday.
