# What happens if my child or family member starts to display Covid-19 symptoms in the first two weeks of the holiday?

You will need to access the NHS 111 online portal or call 119 to arrange a test. If the test is positive then please email admin@wardenhill. gloucs.sch.uk with the subject box as 'Confirmed Covid Case'.

We will then get in touch with the rest of the bubble members to let them know as these children will to self-isolate for 14 days.

The household of the wider group do not need to isolate unless the contact (child member from the bubble) subsequently develops symptoms.

If your child or you develop Covid-19 symptoms after this two week period (from Monday 3rd August onwards) please follow the above and take advice from Public Health England regarding the test outcome.








Year 4 children were set the task of writing a poem and the idea was to link it with the water cycle, which they focus on in their Science task.
