In the first couple of days of a class having to self-isolate, the children will have brought home a home learning pack to keep their learning going.

During this time the teaching team will adapt the planned lessons to ensure that they are easily accessed at home. In addition to the type of work carried out during lockdown, teaching videos will be uploaded by the team which will contain new curriculum content. This is to ensure that our children continue to make progress and it will allow you to manage the day if you have limited computer devices.

Mr Jefferies visited our school today to speak to our Year 5 and Year 6 children. He shared a video with them and answered as many questions as he could. Through the course of the session it was evident that many of the children's worries about transferring to secondary school were addressed. 
Whole School Assemblies










House Points Update








Leaves of Kindness


Following Mrs Flooks' assembly on kindness, year 2 pupils thought about when they have been kind to others.











New Reading Scheme in Key Stage 1
