PGL Information for Parents

Dear Parents

We have been waiting for some time now for information from Osmington Bay (PGL) in order for us to be able to finalise our plans and we appreciate your patience with this.

We would like to confirm a few details with you, some that were shared on the information evening and others that we have now been able to determine.

The children should arrive at school at normal time on Monday 11th July where they will be invited straight in to the hall with their luggage. Mr Williams and Mr Herbert will be in the hall and will collect all medicines and wallets/purses. Both should be named clearly on the outside. Please ensure that any medication is clearly labelled with the following: **your child's name, the dosage and the frequency and timing of when the medicine is needed** (e.g. John Smith, 2 x tablets daily, taken in the morning). Medication that is required throughout the day, like inhalers, will be kept with your child's group leader for ease of access. All other medication will be stored securely and given as per the instructions. We will take Paracetamol/Calpol with us should it be needed and we ask that you give permission for us to administer this in the first instance. **(See xpression Form).**

We are aiming to leave Warden Hill at approximately 11.30am from Durham Close should you wish to come and wave your child off.

During the trip, we have a scheduled stop, around halfway, in order to eat lunch. All children will need to bring a packed lunch which can be easily discarded at the service station to avoid carrying empty lunchboxes or unnecessary rubbish.

We will send updates during the week, including when we have arrived and also our ETA on return.

We are really looking forward to welcoming the children back from their respective secondary transitions and having a wonderful time at PGL.

Should you have anything you need to make us aware of prior to departure, please send a message via Xpressions to the school office. We will be available on departure day should there be any last-minute notices.
