RSE PSHCE Unit Information Session

As you will be aware, the year 6 children have yet to be taught the 'Relationships and Sex Education' (RSE) PSHCE unit that was due to be delivered in year 5 but was postponed due to the first lockdown in April 2020. You were informed earlier this year, alongside completing the consultation, that this would be completed in year 6.

As a year 6 team, we are hosting a short Google Meet session, where we will outline the topics covered within the RSE sessions. This meeting will take place on **Monday 26th April at 17:00**. A link for you to access the Google Meet session will be sent to you via xpressions on the day and we will also post the link to the stream on the Year 6 Google Classroom about 5 minutes beforehand (this method may be easier to access if you do not intend to stream the meeting on the device from which you receive xpressions). Please note: you will need to access this meet using your child's Google Classroom email address.

Following this meeting we will be teaching the RSE sessions from the week beginning 3rd May 2021, following the bank holiday. Your children will be engaging with the following objectives over the course of the unit:

- To know and understand the physical changes that take place in puberty and why they happen
- To understand that emotional and physical changes happen at different rates
- To recognise their own changing emotions and be able to express feelings and concerns positively
- To consider new aspects of personal hygiene relevant to puberty
- To know about the facts of the human life cycle, including sexual intercourse
- To consider different types of love
- To understand how babies are born and to explore the impact a new baby has on a family

We encourage you to discuss any of these areas with your children before during or after our topic, as children and young people say that they greatly value being able to talk their parents about these issues.
